

# What to Bring to Camp (Please mark EVERYTHING with camper's name!)

## Required Equipment:

- Bedding -- Sleeping bag or bedding for a twin bed – The most comfortable is a bottom fitted sheet, top sheet and comforter or sleeping bag. Adventure campers may also want to bring a foam pad to use under sleeping bag on adventure overnights.
- Pillow & pillowcase
- Towels – Bring 2, one for showers and one for swimming
- Toilet Articles – Toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, brush, deodorant, shampoo, soap, etc.
- Sunscreen (non aerosol please)
- Bug spray (non aerosol if possible, as its damaging to cabins and nature)
- Camper medications
- Water bottle
- Clothes – Camp gets messy. Bring at least one outfit that can get dirty.
  - Shorts
  - T-shirts
  - Underwear
  - Socks
  - Pajamas
- Jeans pants, in case it's cool or sweat
- Swimsuit
- Jacket or sweatshirt
- Close-toed sturdy walking shoes for hiking & camp activities (tennis or running shoes are fine.)
- Water shoes for lake use (**MUST HAVE!** Inexpensive ones are perfectly fine)
- White T-shirt (for tie dye)
- Notebook
- Pen or pencil

*...and a positive attitude!*

## OPTIONAL ITEMS

- Bible (we have some to use, if you don't have one)
- Sandals (optional) with a strap to secure sandal to feet
- Shower shoes (flip flops) for pool & cabin use
- Rain Gear – poncho or rain coat or umbrella
- Flashlight or headlamp
- Small backpack or book bag
- Inexpensive or disposable camera
- Musical Instrument - Guitar, flute, or other instruments
- Sketch pad or journal and a few books for reading
- Address list of friends and relatives
- Favorite stuffed animal or photos from home
- Sports equipment
- Deck of cards
- Non electronic games
- Costumes, wigs, funny clothing for special occasions

**Things not to Bring: Drugs, alcohol, or tobacco products, weapons of any kind (this includes knives, guns, or explosives (including fireworks)), and expensive items that you do not want to take a chance of losing or breaking. It is not recommended that campers bring cell phones, mp3 players or ipads to camp. If they do, they must be checked in upon camper's arrival. Use will be permitted once a day during a specified time.**
