CONTEST DETAILS

Based on what you think the Grog could be ([scroll down to read “Grog the Game” and “Grog the Legend” for details on what a “Grog” is!](#)), create what you think the grog looks like. Draw, paint, sculpt or use other artistic mediums to create your grog. The contest is for all ages. Submit your grogs to be voted on by your fellow peers on Facebook. The grogs with the most likes get the prizes, so share with your friends!

Dates:

1. Contest begins October 7th, 2017
2. Submissions due by October 24th, 2017
3. Voting begins upon submission. Have your friends like the page and your picture!
4. Voting Ends October 30, 2017
5. Winners announced on October 31, 2017

Rules:

- ❖ Persons of all ages may enter the contest once.
- ❖ Parents and/or caretakers may enter on behalf of their children or participant if the person does not have a Facebook.
- ❖ Submissions must include: Picture of the art, name of the participant, very brief description of your grog and why you think the grog looks the way it does.
- ❖ Do not write your name on the art piece itself.
- ❖ May design, draw, paint, sculpt, build, from any material so long as its an original piece.

WAYS TO SUBMIT ART

We will work with you to plan your ideal day at camp complete with pizza and ice cream Pick your favorite activities in any order. Who knows, you may have a new idea of something to try at camp, you are the camp director after all! (check for available dates. May – September 2018)

GROG THE GAME:

Grog is one of our favorite games played here at camp. 'Tis a tag game played in the dark. People scavenge for 3 pieces of a flashlight, or search through treasure chests for the only working flashlight. Meanwhile, the grog who is "it" crawls around tagging and freezing players. Don't get frozen while you have the parts to the flashlight, because you can't talk and your fellow players will never beat the grog without the light. Once the flashlight is found and/or assembled, players shine the light at the grog and win the game. If the grog tags all players before the flashlight is found and shone, the grog wins the game.

GROG THE LEGEND:

White Memorial Camp is one of many places haunted by the grog. The grog's origin is believed to begin around the same time the dam was flooded in the early 1960's creating the reservoir that surrounds the camp. Little is known about the creature. Some think it's a transformed grumpy camp counselor who was in the lake when it flooded. Others think it is a lake monster from the dinosaur days. What does it sound like? What does it look like? Where does it live? What does it want? Some thinks it hates fun and tries to spread fear. Others think its afraid of the dark and is thankful when the flashlight is shone on it. Is it friend or foe? We may never know. All we know is... its creepy!
